he unexpectedly found himself teaching literacy to maximumsecurity prisoners, adapting by using minimal resources like flipchart paper and hospital beds as desks.

Rev. Vaccarino also discussed the Family Literacy Project, which promoted reading among parents and children in rural and underresourced areas in South Africa.

He described the challenges of rural education there, with overcrowded classrooms, limited resources, and the impact of HIV/AIDS on orphan populations. He further explained the broad range of community programs he's currently involved in, such as free entertainment and fitness classes for seniors, English lessons for senior refugees, and social programs for parents and young children.

These programs focus on inclusion and connection, ensuring vulnerable groups feel supported and engaged. He highlighted the need for transportation services to help participants access these activities.

Rev. Vaccarino concluded by addressing efforts to help international students in New Zealand integrate with the local community and language. Through initiatives like community breakfasts, he emphasized creating more opportunities for people to connect and support one another in meaningful ways.
