Report on meeting Monday 21 July

Guest speaker **Aaron Fulton, EO ManawaTech**

Aaron Fulton's Journey & Early Tech Work

Aaron attended Massey University and became involved in the local tech scene. He co-founded a company that developed **farm fuel tank monitoring systems** for logistics, fuel theft prevention, and compliance. It expanded to monitor milk temperature in response to MPI regulations, growing to operate in 30 countries.

Starting ManawaTech

Aaron, with others, initiated a **formal industry body** in 2020, post-COVID, called **ManawaTech**, with the aim to connect and grow the local tech community. Key initial steps:

- Aaron a Board member
- 45 local companies paying a membership.
- Benji Pritchard Executive officer appointed.
- Aaron now interim Executive Officer.

Purpose and Vision

The organisation aims to:

- **Connect:** Foster collaboration between local tech companies and students, increasing visibility and communication.
- **Grow:** Support workforce development and promote career pathways from junior to senior tech roles.

The Local Tech Landscape

- **Around 120 tech companies** operate in Palmerston North, many focused on business-to-business services and not well-known.
- Examples include:
- **ITL:** Integrates fuel pump systems with point-of-sale tech.
- **Objective:** Builds council software with 40+ local staff.
- **FMG:** Develops internal insurance management systems.

ManawaTech's Activities

- Organises **Tech Week** and other networking/training events.

- Works to build the region's tech profile to retain Massey graduates.
- Promotes knowledge sharing and career pathways to grow regional tech capability.

Looking Ahead

Manawātū Tech plans to continue strengthening connections while expanding the local talent pool and capabilities of the tech sector. They operate on a lean structure—currently about 10 hours a week of paid staffing—and rely on continued business support and volunteer contributions.

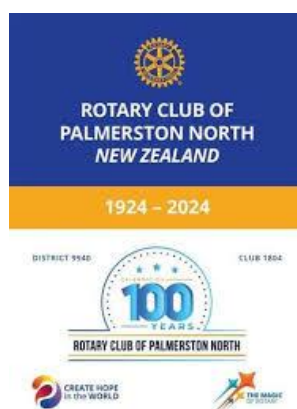
